



SUBJECT DOWNING OF THE U.S. CREWMEN AND JET AIRCRAFT



1. AT ABOUT 0703 HOURS ON 26 JANUARY 1973, TWO CREWNEN
BAILED OUT CF A U.S. F-4H JET FIGHTER BOMBER WHICH WAS SHOT DOWN
OVER TRIEU PHUOC VILLAGE, TRIEU PHONG DISTRICT, QUANG TRI
PROVINCE, SOUTH VIETNAM (SVN), BY 12.8MM ANTIAIRCRAFT HACHINE
GUN FIRE FROM AN UNIDENTIFIED NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY (NVA) UNIT.
ONE CREWMAN, IN A RED PARACHUTE, WAS CAPTURED BY THE VIET CONG
(VC) TRIEU PHUOC VILLAGE GUERRILLA UNIT AFTER LANDING, HE WAS
MOUNDED IN THE LEFT THIGH. THE OTHER CREWMAN, WHO BAILED OUT
IN A WHITE PARACHUTE, WAS SHOT AND KILLED BY SMALL ARMS FIRE
DURING HIS DESCENT.

2. THE SURVIVOR AND THE BODY OF HIS COMPATRICT LANDED AT LUDNS KIM HAMLET (YD333652). TRIEU PHUGG VILLAGE, TRIEU PHONG DISTRICT, AND THE AIRCRAFT CRASHED INTO THE SEA. THE

HOUNDED CREWHAN WAS BANDAGED AND ESCORTED ON FOOT TO THE COMMAND SECTION OF THE VC TRIEU PHONG DISTRICT UNIT AT GIA DO HAMLET CYD279635). TRIEU DO VILLAGE, TRIEU PHONG DISTRICT, BY TWO SOLDIERS OF THE VC TRIEU PHUOC VILLAGE GUERRILLA UNIT. HE STAYED IN THE MAMLET UNTIL THE NEXT MORNING WHEN HE WAS TAKEN OF FOOT TO THE SECURITY SECTION OF THE VC QUANG TRI PROVINCE PARTY COMMITTEE. DURING HIS OVERNIGHT STAY IN THE MAMLET. THE CREWHAN WAS PROVIDED WITH MEDICAL CARE, CHINESE CANNED FOOD AND A SET OF BLACK PAJAMAS. THE CREWHAN WAS A CAUCASIAN AND AN AIR FORCE COLONEL, WHO WAS BORN IN 1935, WARRIED AND HAD TWO CHILDREN. HE WAS ABOUT 1.80 METERS TALL. WEIGHED ABOUT 72 KILOS AND HAD CREWCUT BLOND HAIR, A THIN FACE AND HEAVY EYEBROWS. HE HAD JUST COME TO VIETNAM AND WAS ON HIS FIRST FLYING HISSION.

- 3. THE DECEASED CREWMAN WAS ALSO CAUCASIAN. HIS BODY WAS BURIED AT THE SITE OF LANDING BY MEMBERS OF THE VC TRIEU PRUCC VILLAGE GUERRILLA UNIT.
- GUIDE A SEARCH PARTY BACK INTO THE AREA BECAUSE OF FEAR OF POSSIBLE VC REPRISAL. HE SAID THAT ANY MEMBERS OF THE VC

TRIEU PHUCC VILLAGE GUERRILLA UNIT WOULD BE ABLE TO LOCATE THE BURIAL CITE OF THE DEAD CREWNAN.



5. (FIELD COMMENT: THE JOINT CASUALTY RESOLUTION

CENTER (JCRC) COMMENTED AS FOLLOWS ON THE PRECEDING REPORT.

**THIS REPORT DESCRIBES THE INCIDENT INVOLVING NAVY

LCDR PHILLIP ALLEN KIENTZLER (JCRC NR 1976) AND COMMANDER

MARLEY MUDERT MALL (JCRC NR 1977). LCDR KIENTZLER AND CMDR

HALL WERE FLYING AN FAJ ON A STRIKE MISSION OVER SVN. THEID

AIRCRAFT WAS DOWNED BY ANTIAIRCRAFT FIRE ON 27 JANUARY 1973. LCDR

KIENTZLER STATED IN DEGRIEFING THAT HE THOUGHT HIS

CREWMENBER WAS KILLED WHILE DESCENDING IN HIS PARACHUTE.


WHEN HE ASKED THE NVA GUARD ABOUT HIS CREWMENDER, THEY

INDICATED THAT CMDR HALL WAS DEAD. LCDR KIENTZLER WAS WOUNDED

IN THE LEFT LEG DURING DESCENT. LCDR KIENTZLER IS CARRIED IN

A RELEASED STATUS: CMDR HALL IS CARRIED IN A CAPTURED, CONFIRMED
