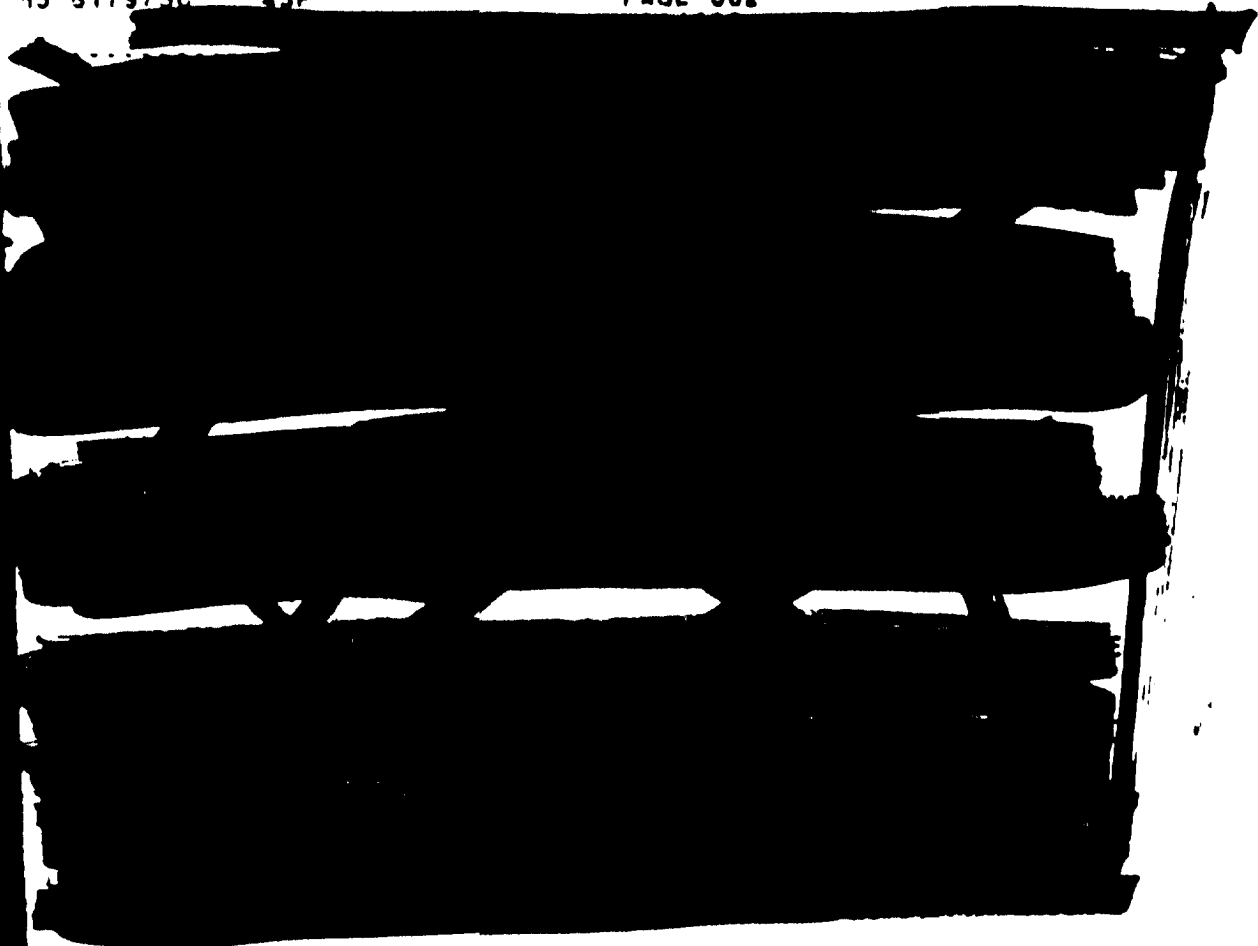

EL SALVADOR: PROBE OF TERRORIST KILLINGS

//PRESIDENT DUARTE HAS URGED HIS DEFENSE MINISTER TO ORDER POLICE AND MILITARY UNITS TO COOPERATE MORE CLOSELY IN INVESTIGATING THE TERRORIST MASSACRE OF US AND SALVADORAN CITIZENS ON 19 JUNE. ANWHILE, THE SALVADORAN NATIONAL GUARD EARLIER THIS WEEK CAPTURED POSSIBLE SUSPECT IN THE KILLINGS.

[REDACTED] SAID THE ATTACK HAD NOT BEEN COORDINATED WITH GUERRILLA LEADERS.//

COMMENT: //DUARTE'S ORDER COMES IN RESPONSE TO AN APPARENT LACK OF COLLABORATION AMONG UNITS CHARGED WITH THE INVESTIGATION AND INDICATES THE GOVERNMENT'S CONCERN THAT THE OFTEN-COMPETITIVE POLICE AND MILITARY AGENCIES MAY BE HAMPERING THE PROBE. GREATER COOPERATION AMONG THE VARIOUS AGENCIES INVOLVED, TOGETHER WITH INFORMATION FROM [REDACTED] COULD LEAD TO OTHER ARRESTS. / [REDACTED]
