IN JUIAN, CHEKIANG, TRANSPORTATION HAD STILL NOT BEEN RESTORED BY 13 OCTOBER. IN YUNGCHIA, CHEKIANG, FIGHTING HAS BEEN GOING ON CONTINUOUSLY SINCE 15 MAY.) END SUMMARY.
