1. PRESIDENT SUKARNO HAS GIVEN INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUSTAINED HARASSMENT OF AMERICAN OFFICIALS IN INDONESIA. CHIEF OF ARMED FORCES STAFF INTELLIGENCE DIRECTORATE (DINSAB) GENERAL MAGENDA TOLD A GROUP OF HIS OFFICERS ON 2 MARCH THAT THE GOVERNMENT'S INTENTIONS ARE TO GRADUALLY STEP UP THIS HARASSMENT UNTIL A PEAK IS REACHED IN JUNE. SEPARATE EFFORTS ARE TO BE AIMED AT AMERICAN MAIL, HOUSING, AND SERVANTS, THE LATTER TO BE MOUNTED UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE NATIONAL FRONT. (SOURCE COMMENT: MAGENDA GAVE NO ASSIGNMENTS FOR HARASSMENT

3. (FIELD COMMENT: FND 7511( TDCS-314/00496-65 ) FROM AN  
INDEPENDENT SOURCE QUOTED SUKARNO AS SAYING THAT, FACING THE PROSPECT  
OF ALL-OUT WAR WITH CHINA OVER VIETNAM, THE AMERICANS WILL FIND IT  
NECESSARY TO REPAIR THEIR RELATIONS WITH INDONESIA. THE PRICE  
OF THIS , SUKARNO MADE CLEAR, WOULD BE SUPPORT FOR BREAKING  
UP MALAYSIA.)
