Hans Mosberg is a German newspaperman, at present in Shanghai. He is about 46 to 48 years old. During 1914-1918 he was an officer of the German army.

After the war he was correspondent for the Deutsche Allgemeine Zeitung in Warsaw till he lost his position there, being not of pure Aryan origin.* He was a newspaperman in New York from 1939 to 1941. Some time during 1941 he went to the Far East, hoping to find his wife and children there who had been refused U.S. visas in Germany under various pretexts.

Mosberg is a very capable and intelligent man. He does not want to return to Germany but to stay in the United States and settle down on a small farm.

*In Warsaw he was mediator in various matters between the Senate of Danzig and the Polish Government.
