



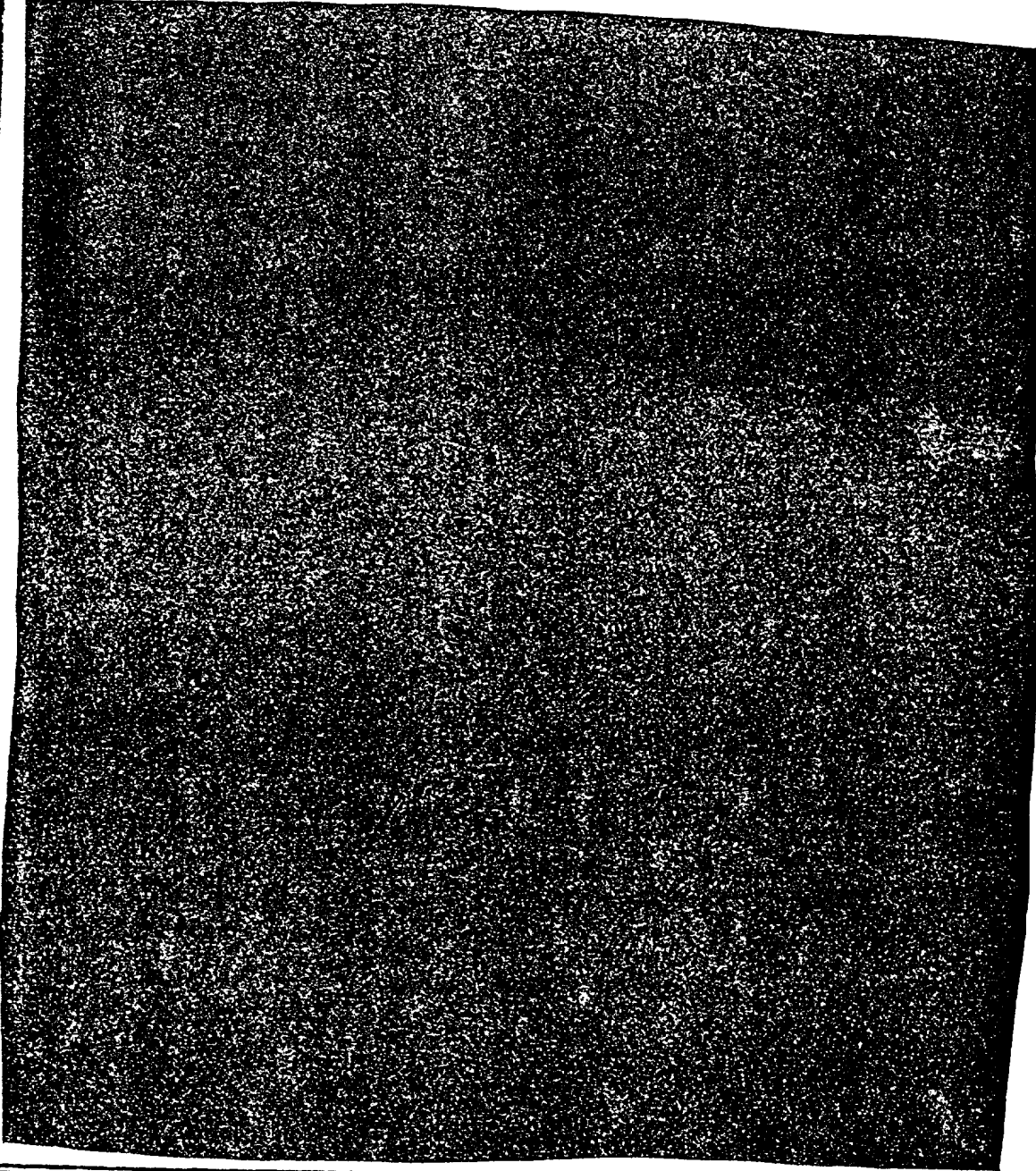

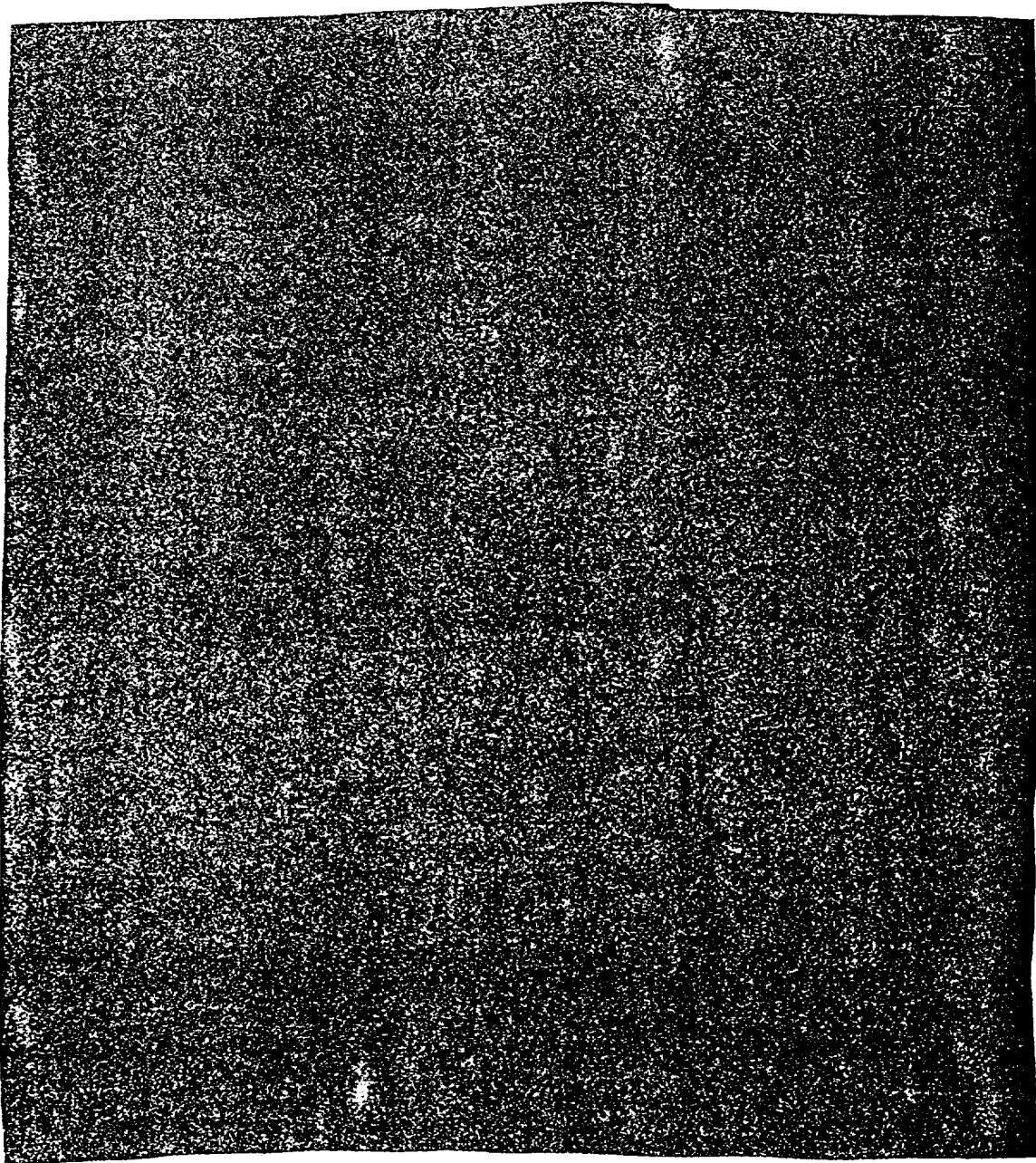

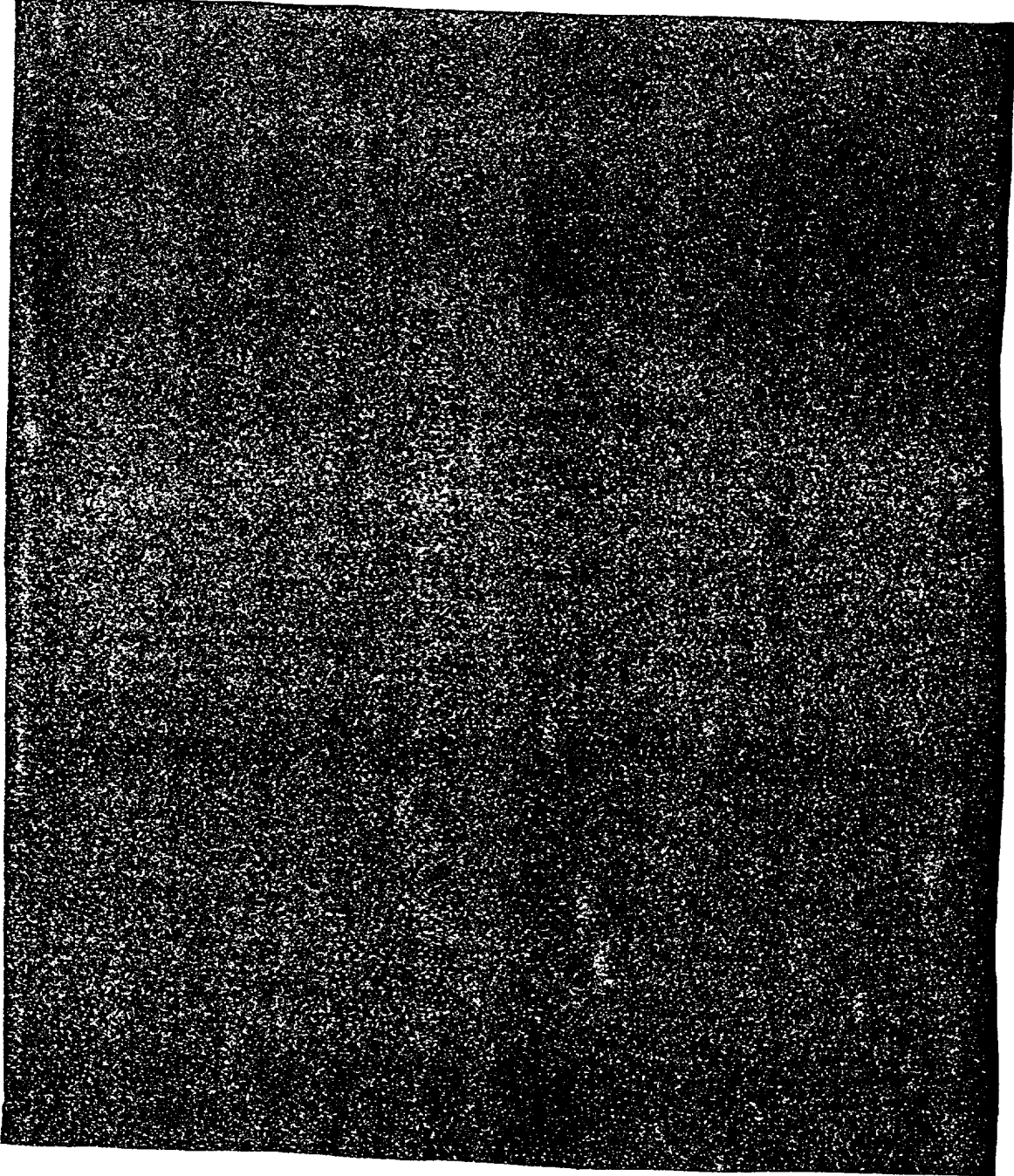
**Iran Protests Iraqi Aircraft Landings**

Iran yesterday formally submitted a letter to the UN Secretary General protesting Iraqi aircraft landings in Iran and reaffirming Tehran's intention to hold those aircraft and

their crews until hostilities in the Gulf are over, according to the US Mission to the UN. Iran's UN Ambassador said publicly yesterday that an Iraqi delegation led by Deputy Prime Minister Hammadi is in Tehran to discuss Iran's protests about the aircraft landings, according to press reports. Iran reportedly also will use the Iraqi delegation's visit to explore diplomatic solutions in the Gulf.
