1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: Determine the current location of Terry Waite. In a separate effort, determine the current location of Terri Anderson.

- 2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Utilizing Encrypted Coordinates 780701/324843 (Terry Waite) and Encrypted Coordinates 513336/212773 (Terri Anderson), conduct a search effort and determine the respective locations of Waite and Anderson respectively. Time permitting, provide additional data related to the target structure, the general target area and the personnel present at the target site.
- 3. (S/NP/SK) COMMENTS: No physical inclemencies noted. Viewer 018 perceives Waite and Anderson as being collocated and in the presence of two other (Non-US national) hostages. Viewer 079's summary and sketches are attached as enclosures.



- 1) Terry Waite (labeled "A" in Fig. 3) is located in one corner of the front, right room. He appears to be in good condition, but is bored, sad, and hungry. He is feeling both personal pride, and a deep degree of uncertainty, brought on by the boredom. The uncertainty is not about his future, but is more of a moral and/or religious uncertainty. He seems to be faced with the question as to whether what he is doing at this time (which is little more than staring at walls and waiting) is true martyrdom, or an indication that his whole effort was a mistake.
- 2) Across the hall is another hostage (labeled "B" in Fig. 3) who gives the impression of being in bad physical shape. This hostage also gives a strong impression of being "non-American" (AOL: French).
- 3) Down the hall, on the same side as Waite, are two more hostages (labeled "C" and "D" in Fig. 3), apparently in the same room at the time of viewing. They seem to be in acceptable physical condition. They have formed a friendship, and seem to be just biding time, having accepted their situation. One (labeled "C") appears to be Terry Anderson, while the other gives the strong impression of also being "non-American".
- 4) There are 3 or 4 personnel in the back room of the building, on the same side as Waite. They seem to be guards. There were impressions that they wear tan uniforms.
- 5) Across the hall from them is a cook. The kitchen gave impressions of dirty and small, almost as though it were makeshift.
- 6) There is one perimeter guard in the front of the compound, who did not appear to walk more than the front fence. He also tends the front gate. There were no impressions of perimeter guards on the other sides of the compound.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOR SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL INTELLIGENCE

SUBJECT: SUN STREAK REPORT (U)

- 1. (S/NF/SK) On 26 January 1988, during the course of a Utility Assessment conducted against Terry Waite as a target personality, Viewer 079 provided substantially the following information:
- a. (S/NF/SK) Viewer 079 perceived Terry Waite as currently being held captive near an old temple currently not in use and located three kilometers south of Beirut. Shiite moslems were responsible for the abduction of Waite. The temple is located along an old alley and a purple cloth hung as a veil is identifiable with the temple. A cross bearing gold and white stones is also perceptible (See Enclosure 1). Despite his status as a hostage, Waite continues to negotiate from within for the release of the other hostages. His captors consider Waite a political lever of significant influence. Viewer 079 anticipates that barring the unforeseen, hostage negotiations will take place in May 1988. Terry Waite along with two other hostages, will be returned to neutral territory in August 1988. Rudolf Cordes, German national who is also being held as a hostage, will be released in June 1988. Information provided by Cordes will be instrumental in the release of Waite and the other two hostages. Terry Anderson, the American national being held hostage, will be the last of the captives to be released. Anderson will be released in late August 1988, subsequent to Waite's release from captivity.
