Its leader, LIANG P'ei**, also known as YAMG Ching-ming, is an experienced Communist underground worker. He is employed by the Man Kuang Company as a tallyman; in the name of the firm he was able to obtain from the Portuguese authorities four unsigned gun licenses for his group.

3. The functions of the operations team are to carry out terrorist activities, such as bombings and assassinations, as ordered by the commissioner's office, and to manage the transportation of arms and munitions to the Philippines,

Viet Linh and Lalaya. The Special Commissioner of the Political Department of the Eacao Government indicated, after an investigation, that the murder

and bombing incidents in Macao in May 1950 were the work of this team. No police action has been taken, however. ***
