- The office of the Chinese Communist special commissioner in Macao operates under cover of the Nan Kuang (南光) Trading Company, Ho Pien Hsia (何平夏) Street, Hsia Huan (下環), in southwest Macao.
- Under the Communist commissioner's office a twelve-man operations team* is functioning as a terrorist group. Its leader, LIANG P'ei**, also known as YANG Ching-ming, is an experienced Communist underground worker. He is employed by the Nan Kuang Company as a tallyman; in the name of the firm he was able to obtain from the Portuguese authorities four unsigned gun licenses for his group.
- The functions of the operations team are to carry out terrorist activities, such as bombings and assassinations, as ordered by the commissioner's office, and to manage the transportation of arms and munitions to the Philippines, Viet Minh and Malaya. The Special Commissioner of the Political Department of the Macao Government indicated, after an investigation, that the murder and bombing incidents in Macao in May 1950 were the work of this team. No police action has been taken, however.***
