SUBJECT: Name DAUFEILD

1. Recent interrogations of Karl Heinz KRAMER, one of the major SIS figures in Sweden during the war, have indicated that there was a connection, not previously known, between him and DAUFEILD. There is reason to believe that DAUFEILD, when he was in Referat VI-B at Berlin in 1941, recommended that KRAMER be assigned to Stockholm. It is possible that DAUFEILD knows some important aspects of KRAMER's activities which are still not cleared up.

2. We should therefore appreciate it very much if you could arrange to have DAUFEILD asked the following questions. While it would be preferable to have the questions put by an interrogator, they might be handled as home-work if it is necessary.

QUESTIONS:

1. What does DAUFEILD know about the assignment of Karl Heinz KRAMER to Stockholm in 1941? Did DAUFEILD have something to do personally with the assignment? Why was KRAMER given an appointment abroad anyhow, and why specifically to Stockholm?
2. What did Obit. HENG know about this appointment of KRAMER? Did HENG have a part in arranging it? If so, details.
3. What does DAUFEILD know about intelligence secured from Switzerland for KRAMER? What details can he give of material obtained there for KRAMER (or other members of the SIS) by the Finnish IS?
4. What does he know about sources of the Finnish IS in Switzerland?
5. What does he know about KRAMER's exploitation of material obtained from Switzerland?
