SUBJECT: NAME DAUFELDT

1. Recent interrogations of Karl Heinz KRAEMER, one of the major SIS figures in Sweden during the war, have indicated that there was a connection, not previously known, between him and DAUFELDT. There is reason to believe that DAUFELDT, when he was in Referat VI-D at Berlin in 1941, recommended that KRAEMER be assigned to Stockholm. It is possible that DAUFELDT knows some important aspects of KRAEMER's activities which are still not cleared up.

2. We should therefore appreciate it very much if you could arrange to have DAUFELDT asked the following questions. While it would be preferable to have the questions put by an interrogator, they might be handled as home-work if it is necessary.

QUESTIONS:

1. What does DAUFELDT know about the assignment of Karl Heinz KRAEMER to Stockholm in 1941? Did DAUFELDT have something to do personally with the assignment? Why was KRAEMER given an appointment abroad anyhow, and why specifically to Stockholm?
2. What did Oblt. NERO know about this appointment of KRAEMER? Did NERO have a part in arranging it? If so, details.
3. What does DAUFELDT know about intelligence secured from Switzerland for KRAEMER? What details can he give of material obtained there for KRAEMER (or other members of the SIS) by the Finnish IS?
4. What does he know about sources of the Finnish IS in Switzerland?
5. What does he know about KRAEMER's exploitation of material obtained from Switzerland?
