Activities during war: Further to Paras 13 and 18:

Worked in her job in the legal dept. of Centraal Beheer, Amsterdam (Social Security Administration) but helped in a small way, lodging underground workers, distributing papers, doing small courier services - mostly for RVV, one of the larger underground organizations. In September 1944 was asked by the OD (The largest underground org. in Holland), to go through the lines and man a telephone there. RVV people would not let her go, but then suggested that she go through the lines for them to make contact with the Govt. here and obtain answers to certain political and economic questions. She arrived here and asked the help of Dutch Intelligence in getting these questions answered. This was done and she was immediately recruited by them. This was the middle of December 1944.
