POLAND: More Security Precautions

The government has taken additional measures to ensure its ability to control any strikes or demonstrations today and tomorrow. [REDACTED] in Krakow [REDACTED] more senior Solidarity activists have been arrested there, and [REDACTED] police in Warsaw and Wroclaw have destroyed an underground Radio Solidarity transmitter and printing equipment. Riot police have increased patrols at key points in Warsaw, Wroclaw, and other cities. [REDACTED]

Comment: Even if the government maintains control today, it will retain its increased security precautions through tomorrow in anticipation of large crowds gathering to commemorate Poland's prewar independence day. The regime officially observed this holiday for the first time in 1981 but has given no sign that it is staging ceremonies this year. [REDACTED]
