. Press reports said	
1,000 people organized by the Indian Communist Party-Marxist	
marched yesterday on the US Embassy in New Delhi to protest US	
activities in India, including alleged CIA espionage.	
Comment: Prime Minister Gandhi's decision to delay a public	
statement naming the foreign powers implicated in the spy ring will	
add further to speculation in India—especially in the pro-Soviet	
media—about possible US as well as French involvement. Reports	
that New Delhi is asking Paris and Moscow to recall specified	
diplomats—rather than expelling them—suggest that the Indians are	
trying to minimize the disruptive effect of the investigation on	
relations with the countries implicated. (
