In Chile, the question of admitting a UN Human Rights delegation remains stalemated. The Chileans appeared open to a visit when the head of the working group on Chile--a person anathema to President Pinochet--agreed to stay behind. A Chilean memo

list a number of unrealistic conditions for further movement on this issue. Some of the difficulty in reaching a meeting of minds evidently rests with the tendency of Chilean diplomats to report a glossed version of the negotiations when reporting to the home government. Nevertheless, a UN visit without the working group chairman, Allana, may eventually be palatable to the Chileans.
