Chilean President Pinochet reportedly is so incensed over US co-sponsorship of a UN resolution condemning Chile for human rights violations that he has asked the Foreign Ministry to assess the consequences of a Chilean withdrawal from the UN and its affiliated international organizations. The fact that Cuba was among the nations that joined the US in co-sponsoring the resolution caused particular consternation in Santiago. Foreign Ministry officials believe that it would be a serious mistake for Chile to withdraw from the UN, however, and they are trying to calm the President. The government, meanwhile, has not implemented plans made earlier this year to lift the state of siege on December 11.


