Chileans Observe Coup Anniversary

Chilean security forces are on alert against possible leftist attempts to disrupt the commemoration today of the overthrow of President Allende a year ago. The "Day of National Liberation" will feature a rally in downtown Santiago, tributes to soldiers killed during the coup and its aftermath, and a speech by President Pinochet.

Pinochet probably will list the military government's accomplishments and disclose some of its future plans. He is not likely to set any deadlines for the promised major changes in the nation's political and economic systems.

Pinochet may use the occasion to announce modification of the year-old security measures and make a gesture in the area of human rights. He could announce what the government has decided to do with the Allende cabinet officers and leftist party leaders it has held since the coup.
