1. The most recent Department of Investigations (DI, Chilean civil police) class of detectives consisted of 80 individuals who graduated from the two-year course at the end of 1972.

[REDACTED] These detectives, selected from Communist Party (PCCH) and Socialist Party (PS) sympathizers with the Socialists having the greater representation, have given a higher priority to using the DI as a police force to "defend the revolution" than dealing with criminal problems. They feel that their duties include identifying and purging from the DI personnel who are not sympathetic to the U.P. government.

[REDACTED]. The case of one Fuentes (fnu), assigned to the Mobile Brigade, against whom political accusations were made, is presently under study by a review board. [REDACTED] Comment: The newly graduated detectives were assigned to various units throughout the service, [REDACTED]
