

UNNISE MOVE ON THE PART OF THE GOVERNMENT. VERGARA, HOWEVER.

DENIED THE EXISTENCE OF SUCH ARREST ORDERS.

THAT THE ARREST ORDERS WERE BEING PROCESSED. PINOCHET AGAIN CALLED VERGARA AND TOLD HIM THAT IF THE ORDERS WERE CARRIED OUT. THEY COULD PRECIPITATE ANOTHER GENERAL STRIKE. HE ALSO WARNED THAT THE ARMY HOULD PUBLISH A DECLARATION TO THE EFFECT THAT IT COULD NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONSEQUENCES RESULTING FROM THE ARREST OF THE GUILD LEADERS. IT IS THE UNDERSTANDING OF THE GUILD LEADERS THAT THE ARREST ORDERS WERE THEN EITHER RESCINDED OR AT LEAST HELD BACK FROM FORMAL PRESENTATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF INVESTIGATIONS (DIECKLEAN CIVIL POLICE) FOR ACTION.
