D CARABINERU MEMBER OF THE JUNTA, REGARDING THE EXISTENCE OF  
1 A SPECIAL PRISON CAMP RUN BY THE DINA OUTSIDE THE CITY OF SAN  
1 CARLOS, NURTH OF CHILLAN IN NUBLE PROVINCE. ACCORDING TO THE  
1 REPORT, PRISONERS IN THE CAMP HAVE NOT BEEN DETAINED IN ACCORDANCE  
1 WITH STANDING ARMED FORCES INSTRUCTIONS AND HAVE NOT BEEN RE-  
1 GISTERED WITH ANY LOCAL AUTHORITY. THE REPORT ALSO ACCUSED  
1 DINA OF THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE DEATHS OF SIX PERSONS FOUND  
1 BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN EARLY MAY. THE BODIES WERE FOUND LEFT  
1 BY PUBLIC ROADS, WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION, AND ALL HAD GUNSHOT  
1 WOUNDS.

5. IN LATE MAY, THE THIRD ARMY DIVISION IN CONCEPCION NOTIFIED  
ARMY HEADQUARTERS IN SANTIAGO THAT A CONTINGENT OF FOUR DINA  
OFFICERS HAD BEEN PERMANENTLY ORDERED OUT OF CONCEPCION AREA  
AS A RESULT OF THEIR CONTINUED FAILURE TO COORDINATE THEIR ACTIVITY  
WITH THE DIVISIONAL HEADQUARTERS. THE THIRD DIVISION CONFIRMED  
THE VERACITY OF CHARGES THAT DINA WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATHS

OF THE SIX PERSONS, AS REPORTED BY THE CARABINEROS, AND WAS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR A NUMBER OF OTHER ACTS OF UNNECESSARY VIOLENCE IN THE SAME AREA.

6. SENIOR ARMY OFFICERS IN SANTIAGO, WHO ARE FAMILIAR WITH THE DETAILS OF THE CHARGES, ARE CONVINCED THAT THE PERSONS INVOLVED WERE ACTING ON THEIR OWN AND THAT THE ILLEGAL ACTIONS WERE NOT CARRIED OUT AS A RESULT OF DINA POLICY. THESE OFFICERS UNDERSTAND, HOWEVER, THAT AS A RESULT OF THE CHARGES, DINA'S COORDINATION ROLE WILL BE EXAMINED AT THE UPCOMING MEETING OF ARMY GENERALS, SCHEDULED FOR MID-JUNE IN SANTIAGO.
