

(DI/ALA) and (DI/ALA)—briefed members of the HPSCI staff on reporting relating to the case of Efrain Bamaca Velasquez. Bamaca is a missing Guatemalan guerilla, whose U.S. wife, Jennifer Harbury, is carrying out a hunger strike in Guatemala City to force a Guatemalan Government response to his status. In response to increased focus on this case due Harbury's hunger strike and a related both oversight committees on all CIA reporting/documents on this case.

2. Referring to disseminated reports containing Bamaca's name from early 1993 to the present, provided the chronology of the reported capture, and possible torture and internment of Bamaca. Concluding that the CIA has no information on the current status of Bamaca or on his possible death, DO advised that they are attempting to obtain updated information on Bamaca's fate.


