SUBJECT: Meeting at NSC to discuss BAMACA [REDACTED]

1. On 26 January 1995, DC/LA and DC/LA [REDACTED] attended a meeting at the National Security Council (NSC) office of Mr. Richard Feinberg to discuss how to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. Besides Mr. Feinberg, the meeting was also attended by Mr. George Tenet (NSC), Chat Blakeman (NSC), Ann Patterson (State), Colonel Wilhelm (Office of the Vice President), and a Department of Justice (DOJ) official.

2. The consensus of the NSC and State representatives was that the U.S. Government (USG) must demarche the Guatemalan government with the Alpirez information and that this must be done soon before the information leaks out to BAMACA's wife, Jennifer Harbury. [REDACTED]


[REDACTED]. DC/LA underscored the need for timely notification of the Oversight Committees for which CIA has a statutory obligation. Mr. Tenet requested that Congressional notification be delayed until the Administration is ready to present the demarche to the Guatemalan government. Both Mr. Feinberg and Ms. Patterson supported Mr. Tenet's position.

3. CIA was tasked with doing an analysis of all available data which linked Alpirez to the BAMACA assassination and with providing an assessment on [REDACTED]
