Guatemala Review

1. In connection with your review of Guatemalan-related issues, we would appreciate receiving information concerning CIA personnel and activities that may be uncovered relating to the following areas:

- ♦ Involvement of CIA personnel with Guatemalan military or civilian personnel who had any knowledge of, or may have been involved directly or indirectly in, the death of Michael Devine or the fate of Efrain Bamaca Velasquez;
- ♦ Involvement of CIA personnel with Guatemalan Army officer Julio Roberto Alpirez;
- ♦ Knowledge of or involvement by CIA personnel in destruction of records or failure to report information concerning Devine, Bamaca, Alpirez, or serious human rights abuses against U.S. citizens in Guatemala other than Devine;
- ♦ Information reflecting violations of law by CIA personnel in or relating to Guatemala.

2. We will share with you whatever information we uncover in similar areas concerning personnel from your agency. you for your assistance in this regard.
