6. BECAUSE OF TWO INCIDENTS INVOLVING CONTROLLED GUERRILLAS

[REDACTED] THE TWO INCIDENTS WERE THE SURFACING OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS CASE OF EFRAIN ((@BAMACA)) @VELASQUEZ, A GUERRILLA COLUMN LEADER FROM THE REVOLUTIONARY ORGANIZATION OF PEOPLE IN ARMS (ORPA), AND AN INCIDENT WHERE A CONTROLLED GUERRILLA IN AN OUTLYING MILITARY ZONE TOOK AN AK-47, SHOT AND WOUNDED D-2 OFFICER FNU ((@VALLADARES)) @AFTER THE OFFICER HAD SLAPPED THE GUERRILLA AROUND. THE BAHACA CASE GAINED NOTORIETY AFTER TWO CONTROLLED GUERRILLAS ESCAPED THE D-2 AND TESTIFIED TO THE U.N. HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION IN GENEVA TO HAVING SEEN BAHACA ALIVE IN A CLANDESTINE MILITARY PRISON. [REDACTED] COMMENT: THE BAHACA

STORY WAS A FABRICATION BY THE TWO ESCAPED CONTROLLED  
GUERRILLAS. BAMACA DIED SHORTLY AFTER BEING WOUNDED IN THE  
FIREFIGHT WITH GOVERNMENT FORCES WHICH RESULTED IN HIS CAPTURE.  
THE GUERRILLA WHO SHOT VALLADARES SUBSEQUENTLY FLED AND IS STILL  
BEING SOUGHT BY THE D-2.)
