

MEMORANDUM

21 December 1944.

PROJECT "MIMI"

- 1. OBJECTIVE: The infiltration of an SI agent and his radio operator into the region between Stuttgart and Ulm to a point where the Stuttgart-Munich rail and road traffic can regularly be observed, as requested by the G-2's of the 7th Army and 6th Army Group.
- 2. DISCUSSION: Team will be dropped blind from Lyon near a safe-house in Wurttemberg, where a team of agents already dispatched through the Colmar Pocket are expected to be awaiting them. If the latter are not there, Team is in a position to operate without them.
- 3. PERSONNEL:
  - A. Agent: [REDACTED] worked for French Desk Algiers in France in 1944.
  - B. W/T operator: [REDACTED] Also worked for French Desk Algiers in France in 1944.

Neither agent will be coming to London.
- 4. SUPPLIES: Requirements can in the main be met from 7th Army OSS resources. Certain operational items will be requested from Lt. Palmer, C&D.
- 5. COMMUNICATIONS: By TR-1 - Directly from the field into the 7th Army's station, Sunny Ridge. No equipment will be required from Communications Section in London.
- 6. FUNDS: To be supplied from OSS budgets already approved.
- 7. TIME: Moon period beginning December 28th.
- 8. RECOMMENDATION: That Plans and Operations Staff approve the Project.

a) Point is at Aueffhausen near Gieslingen. approved.
