- (b) To keep forever secret this employment all information which he may obtain by reason thereof (unless released in writing by the Government from such obligation), with full knowledge that violation of such secrecy may subject him to criminal prosecution under the Articles of War, the Espionage Act of 1917, as amended, and other applicable laws and regulations.
- 5. This employment may be terminated by the Government upon thirty (30) days' notice to the Employee, but such termination shall not release the Employee from the provisions of subparagraph 4 (b) hereof.
- 6. (a) All factual disputes arising hereunder shall be decided by the Contracting Officer, subject to written appeal within thirty (30) days by the Employee to the immediate superior of the Contracting Officer; the Employee meantime shall diligently proceed with the performance of his duties hereunder.
- (b) Wherever the term "Contracting Officer" is used in this agreement, it shall include the present Contracting Officer and all successors in office.
