

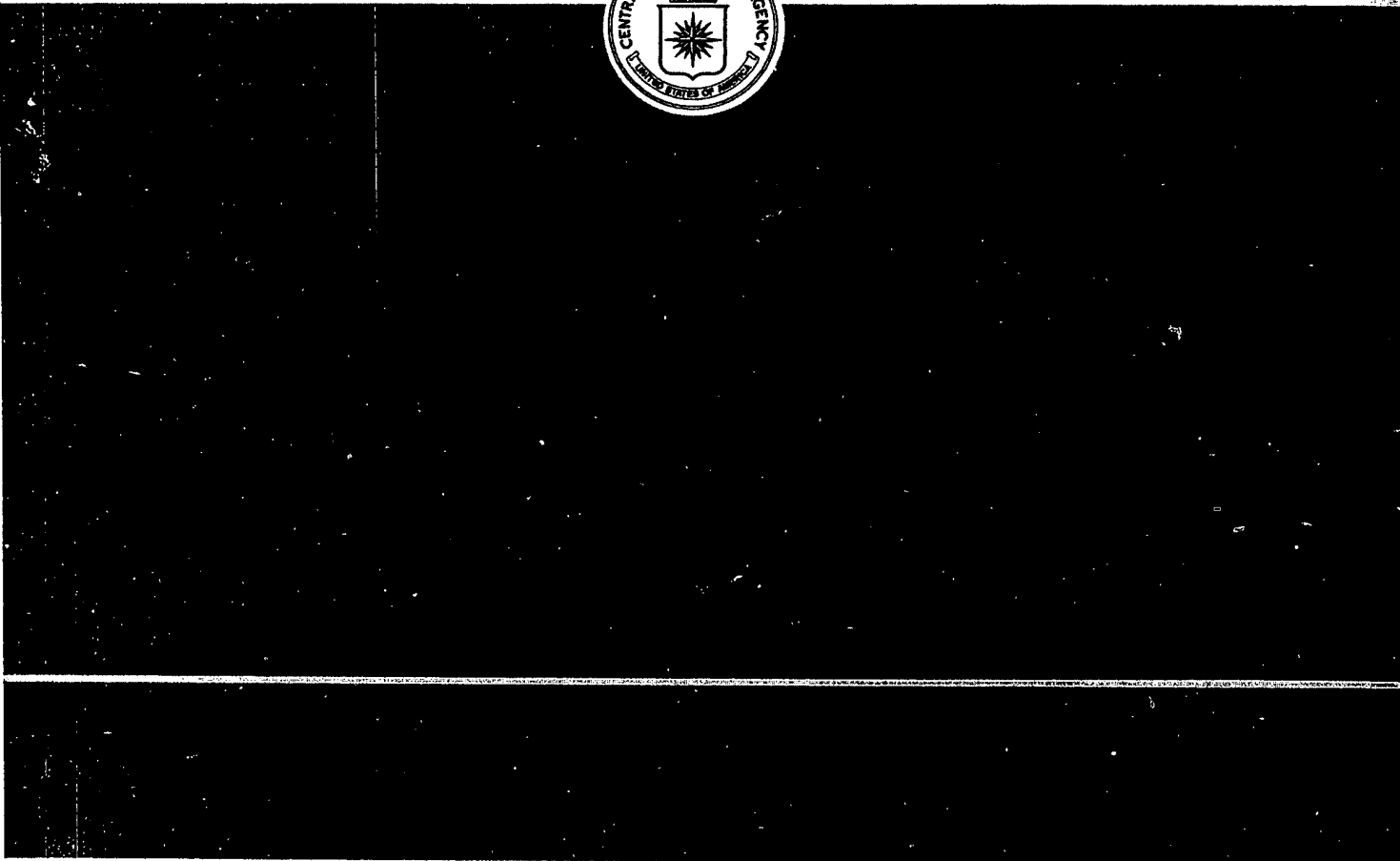

PAKISTAN-US: Prime Minister Bhutto's Visit

Benazir Bhutto arrives in Washington Monday on a trip she hopes will shore up her fragile government and strengthen its ties to the US. [REDACTED]

Bhutto as yet has no substantive domestic achievements to point to and is relying increasingly on foreign visits to present her government in a favorable light. Her meeting with Indian Prime Minister Gandhi in December and trips to Saudi Arabia, Japan, Turkey, and Iraq added to her stature as an emerging leader on the world stage. [REDACTED]
