1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 13 April 1951 on Vassili SOUKHOMLINE and to our previous correspondence on him.

2. On 24 June 1951 we were informed that [redacted] had reported that SOUKHOMLINE is in Prague, Czechoslovakia, where he is in charge of the anti-American section of the Telepresse News Agency. [redacted] added that SOUKHOMLINE writes and disseminates a weekly review in Prague which is sent to Communist Parties throughout the world giving the weekly line to be followed by them.
