**CHILE: Differences Within the Government**

The regime intends to use the 90-day state of siege to crack down vigorously on leftist extremists but will eventually relax some of its measures.

Meanwhile, university student leaders called for a nationwide student strike to begin yesterday; and many political parties plan large-scale protests on 27 and 28 November, according to press reports.

**Comment:**

The opposition's prospects for mounting a major protest are slim in view of the government's determination to enforce the state of siege. The effort may backfire by strengthening Pinochet's preference for a hard line.
