## Item 1519 - Telegraph Equipment

As stated in our memorandum of 13 Hovember 1967, we recommend retention of the provisions of Item 1919. We are especially concerned shout digital data transmission and terminal equipment which is integral to evolving offensive and defensive response systems and early varning systems. We feel that continued embargo of these items will deny to the Communist countries equipment that could significantly upgrade their strategic military posture.

## Item 1520 - Radio Relay Equipment

We estimate that deletion of Item 1520 for the USER and East European Communist countries would not, by itself, significantly enhance the communications posture of these countries. The USER, East Germany, and Hungary produce high capacity minrowave radio relay transmission equipment, but log far behind the West in production of the associated carrier/sultiplex gear. This severely restricts their ability to utilize fully radio relay transmission lines for communications traffic. A provise should be isolated, therefore, that deletion of Item 1520 should not be construed to apply to high capacity radio relay systems (which include the associated carrier/multiplex equipment covered under Item 1523).
