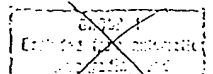

Estimates of Output of Aluminum in the USSR, by Plant

Data on the output of aluminum by individual plants in the USSR are not published. The estimates given below are "rough" indicators of output in 1971. These figures should not be confused with installed capacity which, in every case, would be somewhat larger.
