

APART FROM USING FORCE TO PROTECT THE LEADERSHIP COMPOUND, HAS BEEN SURPRISINGLY DISCIPLINED. POLICE ARE APPARENTLY UNDER ORDERS TO EXERCISE RESTRAINT, AND A WESTERN PRESS REPORT SAYS STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES WERE EVEN ALLOWED INTO THE COMPOUND TO MEET WITH PARTY LEADERS.

THE LEADERSHIP IS TRYING TO DISPLAY AS MUCH STABILITY AND SOLIDARITY AS POSSIBLE IN PREPARATION FOR THE SIND-SOVIET SUMMIT IN BEIJING NEXT MONTH AND MAY BE GAMBLING THAT RESTRAINT WILL DEFUSE TENSIONS. THE STUDENTS, HOWEVER, HAVE SEIZED ON HU'S DEATH AS A PRETEXT TO VENT LONGSTANDING GRIEVANCES AND TEST THE LIMITS OF OFFICIAL TOLERANCE. THEIR APPARENT RESOLVE SUGGESTS FURTHER DEMONSTRATIONS ARE LIKELY, PARTICULARLY ON SATURDAY-THE DAY OF HU'S FUNERAL-AND ON 4 MAY, THE 70TH ANNIVERSARY OF A NATIONWIDE STUDENT MOVEMENT. IF SO. BEIJING WILL BE FORCED TO ABANDON ITS POLICY OF RESTRAINT.

EVEN IF KEPT IN CHECK, THE PROTESTS PROBABLY WILL DEEPEN ALREADY SERIOUS DIVISIONS IN THE LEADERSHIP AS EACH SIDE TRIES TO BLAME THE OTHER FOR THE CURRENT PROBLEMS. BELEAGUERED GENERAL SECRETARY ZHAO, HU'S SUCCESSOR, IS BEING WHIPSAWED BETWEEN ANGERING RIVAL PARTY LEADERS IF HE ADVOCATES CONCILIATION AND ESTRANGING THE REFORMERS AND INTELLECTUALS, IMPORTANT SOURCES OF HIS SUPPORT, IF HE ENDORSES A CRACKDOWN. IN EITHER CASE, HARDLINERS IN THE LEADERSHIP WILL GAIN AT HIS EXPENSE.
