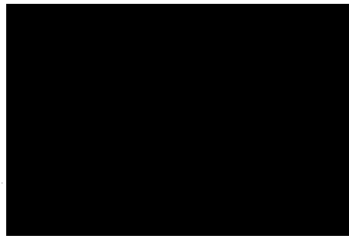

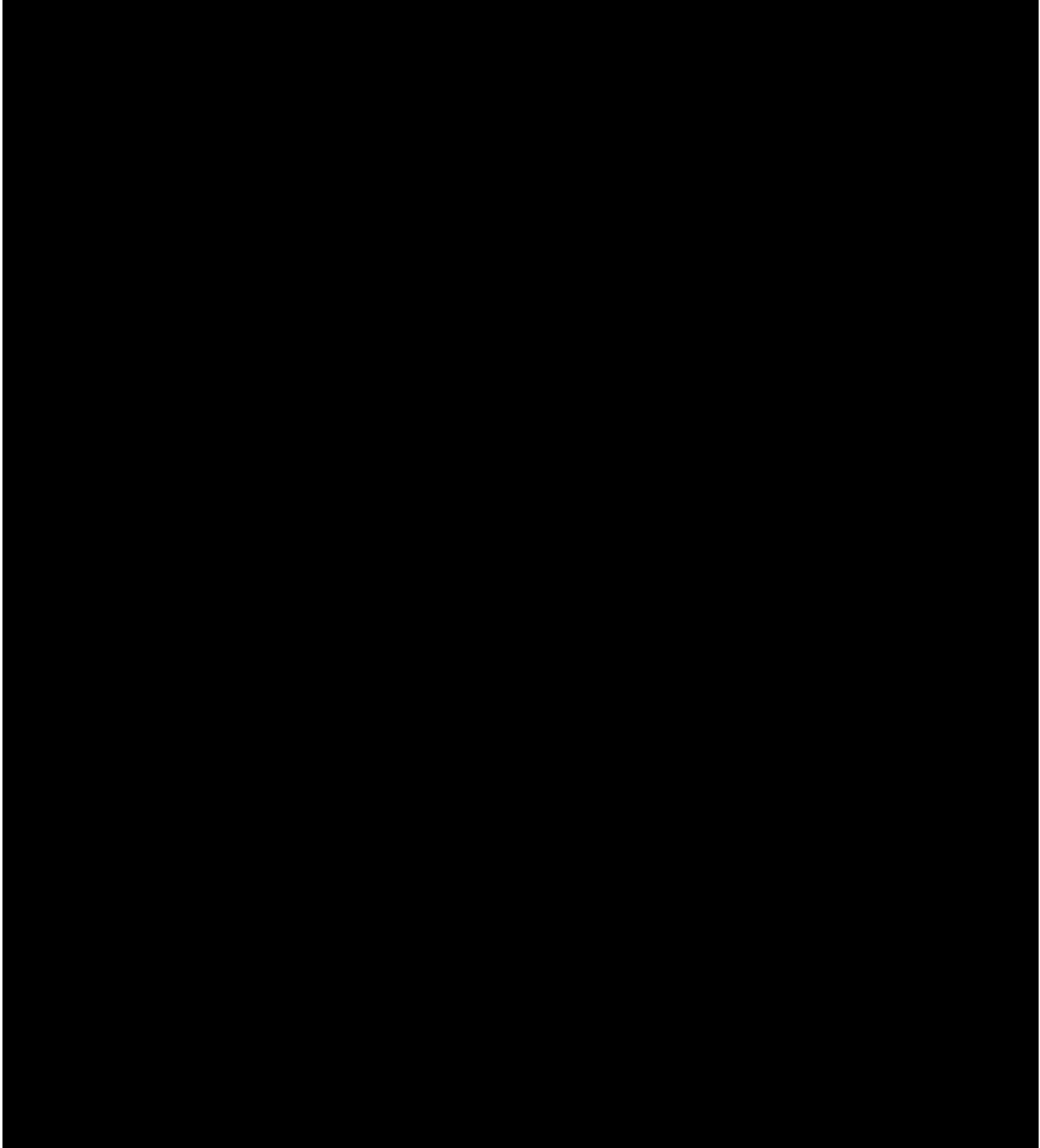

[REDACTED] //The Mexican government's chief concerns tomorrow, presidential election day, will be to avoid an embarrassingly low voter turnout and to head off any terrorist attempts to disrupt the balloting. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] //The government party's pervasive powers and proven voter appeal would assure Lopez Portillo a six-year term even if the election were contested. The only serious opposition group, the conservative National Action Party, could not agree on a candidate in time to make the ballot. Two other small parties, [REDACTED] endorsed Lopez Portillo. Also up for election tomorrow are both houses of congress and one governor.//

[REDACTED] //The 23rd of September Communist League has recently increased its terrorist activities and may try to interfere with the election. [REDACTED]
