1. GUATEMALA: REACTION TO US AIRLIFT

PRESIDENT CEREZO AND MILITARY OFFICERS ARE TRYING TO FORESTALL FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC CHARGES OF DEPENDENCE ON THE US BY PUBLICLY DENYING THAT GUATEMALA FORMALLY REQUESTED THE HELICOPTER AIRLIFT LAST WEEKEND OF MORE THAN 300 OF ITS TROOPS TO SUPPORT COUNTERINSURGENCY OPERATIONS IN REMOTE NORTHWESTERN GUATEMALA. THEY ARE INSISTING THAT THE US WAS PROVIDING ROUTINE TRANSPORTATION FOR NONCOMBAT RECRUITS.

COMMENT: CEREZO PROBABLY REQUESTED THE AIRLIFT TO DEMONSTRATE HIS RESPONSIVENESS TO THE MILITARY'S CONCERNS AND TO SHOW THAT HE WILL LOBBY HARD FOR MILITARY ASSISTANCE DURING HIS OFFICIAL VISIT TO WASHINGTON NEXT WEEK. HE MAY ALSO HAVE WANTED TO ASSURE THE HIGH COMMAND THAT HE INTENDS TO TAKE A STRONG STAND AGAINST MARXIST REBELS IN GUATEMALA DESPITE HIS NEUTRAL POLICY TOWARD NICARAGUA.
