1. On [redacted] December 1965, [redacted] said that [redacted]

[redacted] a new weekly newspaper called Nuevo Mundo Americano will be published in New York starting about mid-December. The weekly publication will follow the same editorial policy as Mundo Americano, it will be printed in color, and Rolando Masferrer Rojas will be the director.

2. Mundo Americano was forced to close because of financial difficulties. [redacted] had been promised \$20,000 [redacted] but the money was not received. When the newspaper was liquidated, the assets totalled about \$37,000, including a \$12,000 deposit on the rent of the printing establishment, \$22,000 in accounts receivable for advertisements, and \$3,000 which was due from the distribution agency.

1. [redacted] Comment. The last issue of Mundo Americano, a Spanish language newspaper published in New York, was the issue of 29 November 1965. Rolando Masferrer Rojas was the executive editor.
