MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR (DCI)

[REDACTED] stated the following points:

Bosch is in direct and constant communication with rebel military leaders.

The rebel military have their troops under control as a cohesive force.

If we can provide the names of the communist leaders, the military officers leading the revolt, they will be arrested and prevented from further action.

If Bosch is permitted to return to the DR, he will in turn give his support to the U. S. military landings.

The following officers are the leaders of the rebel military forces:

- Capt. Francisco Caamano
- Lt. Col. Miguel Hernando Ramirez
- Lt. Col. Emilio Fernandez de la Mota
- Lt. Col. Montes Aracha
- Lt. Col. Pena Taveras
- Capt. La Chapelle

There are troops coming from the country-side to reinforce the rebels. Bosch is willing to make a statement renouncing all communist support. He will only sanction and support the U. S. armed forces landings if permitted to return.
