Rwanda: Military Losing Ground, Control

After two weeks of fighting, the Tutsi-dominated Rwandan Patriotic Front controls most of the north of the country but has not been able to gain complete control of Kigali. [REDACTED]

Ethnic killings are continuing in southern Rwanda, according to press reports. Some 250,000 refugees escaped into Tanzania after Hutu militias abandoned the border checkpoint on Thursday. [REDACTED]
