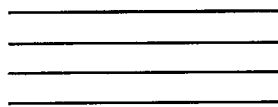

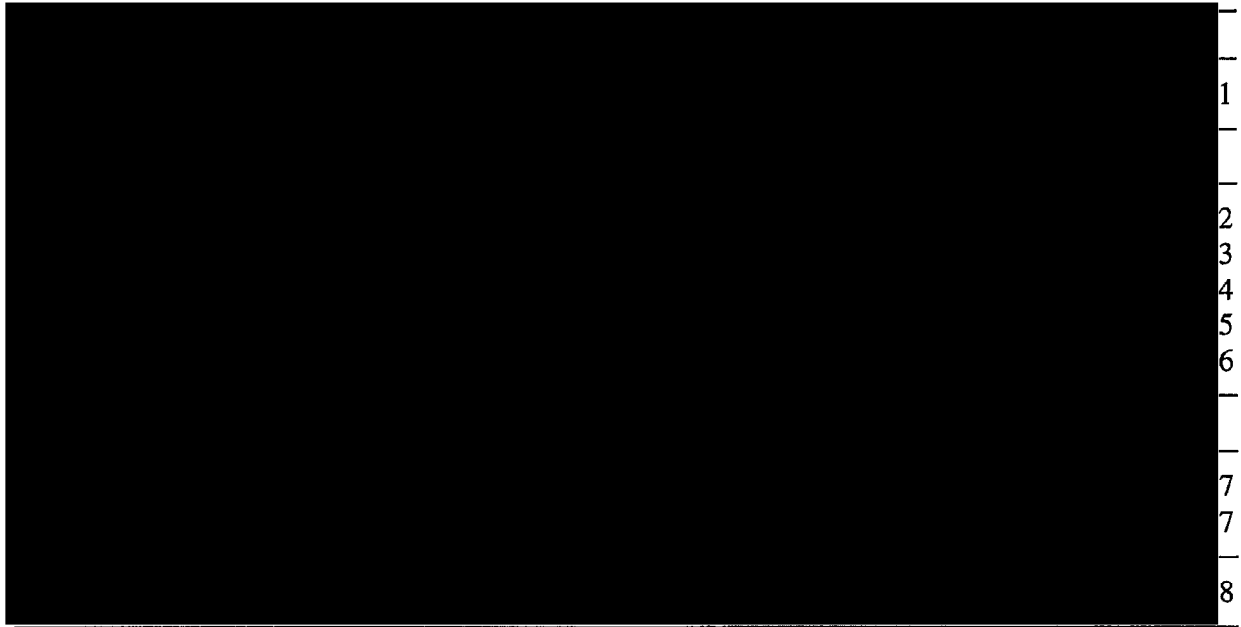

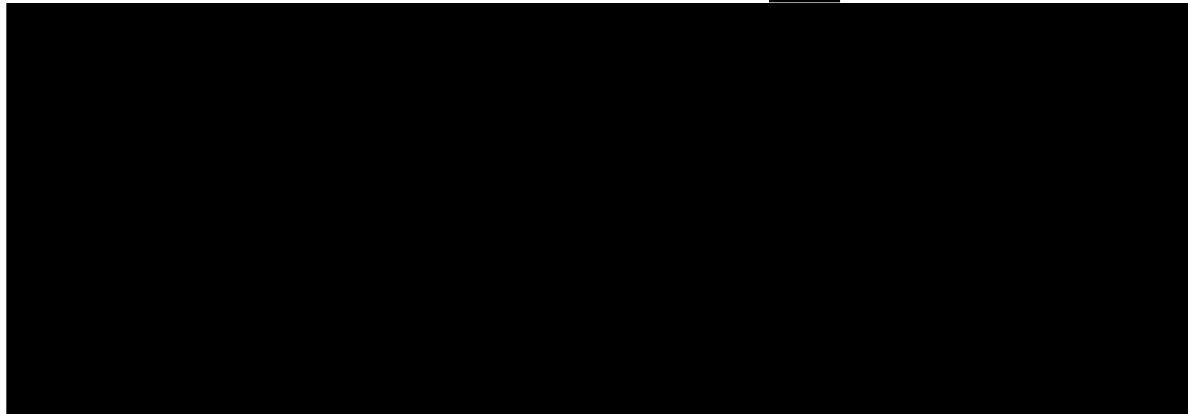

have told US officials a peaceful settlement to the hostage standoff is taking shape, although at a slower pace than they desire. Intermediaries are shuttling between the two sides exchanging settlement proposals.

— *Lima appears ready to free from prison low-level Tupac Amaru Revolutionary Movement (MRTA) members*

believes MRTA leader Cerpa has accepted that the group's top leaders will not be freed, *but the rebel leader's insistence on the release of other prominent MRTA members will keep him at odds with Lima.*

Meanwhile, the heightened tension in the Japanese Ambassador's residence makes a violent outcome a possibility.
