DELEGATES FROM 24 LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES MEETING IN PANAMA HAVE DECIDED TO RETURN THERE ON OCTOBER 15 TO CONSTITUTE THE LATIN AMERICAN ECONOMIC SYSTEM (SELA). A COMMITTEE WILL NOW BEGIN PRE-PARING A DRAFT OF STATUTES FOR THE ORGANIZATION TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE DELEGATES AT THE OCTOBER MEETING.

MOST LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES APPEAR TO AGREE THAT SELA SHOULD HAVE A PRIME GOAL OF DEVELOPING THEIR ECONGOMIES AND PROMOTING THEIR UNIFICATION. HOWEVER, SOME 150 THE GOVERNMENTS PROMOTING THE IDEA OF SELA HAVE STRONG POLITICAL MOTIVES IN MIND.
