

| Tanzanian-brokered negotiations foundered yesterday after the Rwandan  |
| Patriotic Front rebels refused to sign a cease-fire accord that to them implied  |
| recognition of the interim government. Rebel commanders said they would, however, accept deployment of a 5,000-man international force that the UN     |
| has proposed to ensure delivery of humanitarian aid.   |
| — It may take several weeks for the UN to bring in such a force, and<br>the RPF probably will use the time to try to defeat government<br>forces.      |
| — The heavy exchange of artillery fire in Kigali yesterday suggests the rebels are making a concerted push to capture the capital.                     |
| Prime Minister Kambanda, speaking from a town 80 km west of the capital, has called on every able-bodied Rwandan to join the fight against the rebels. |
