DISCUSSION:

1. In general Esterline stated he was now receiving considerable support his level which would mean better service to Lincoln hereafter.
2. Arrangements have been made at Headquarters for [] and a pers together named Sam (name to be provided by cable) ~~to go~~ with [] to arrive Miami on Flt 650, NAL, ETA 2300 Feb. 14 for purposes of briefing on followi day, prior to departure for DTROBALO. Esterline stated they would like to have arrangements made for them to be billeted at LINCOLN. I informed him that if circumstances permitted, [] would meet them at the airpo
3. Regarding HEGARTY's case, Esterline stated he was having difficulty in obtaining full cooperation from the cover officer at HQS and [] assured him that such should not be tolerated and to use necessary pressure from ab to expedite this important assignment. In order to confirm Esterline's position in this matter it was agreed that a cable would be sent immediately from LINCOLN urging such action.
4. Esterline stated that arrangements have been made for a total of 18 men to be assigned at DTROBALO for PM packing and preparation work. Details regarding these personnel would be forwarded later.
