SUBJECT : PBSUCCESS

REFERENCE : Memorandum for the Record, This File, 6 November 1953

1. The Station Chief and Deputy Station Chief had their second conference, on 9 November 1953, with Mr. []
2. The [] men stated definitely that the [] would not dock at [] before 12 November; that it would not be expected to tie up at the [] pier until 13 November.
3. Mr. [] stated that the booking of the [] was tentative and that this booking should be confirmed by [] New York []
4. We gave these men copies of the packing list. They stated that they would prepare the bill of lading and shipper's invoice. The shipper's invoice will show the consignor and the consignee to be International Armament Corporation, New York, New York. Mr. [] stated he required the value of the shipment, which was given him from the import permit.
5. It was agreed that these men would furnish copies of the shipping documents to the undersigned, as soon as prepared, so that the writer could forward them promptly to the consignee in the States.
6. The [] men requested that contact be made with the Port Captain at [] to arrange for pilotage and tug service from [] dock to [] dock. They also requested that the Port Captain be instructed not to send any billing or any papers in this matter to []
