MEMORANDUM FOR: Col. King

1. At 08:30 this morning Mr. Leddy called me and averaged the following:

- (a) That the Military Assistance program treaty with Nicaragua will be announced on April 19. The people concerned with it's implementation will arrive in Nicaragua on April 17.
- (b) The announcement will be restricted to the Nicaraguan Treaty; no announcement will be made with regard to other countries with whom similar treaties have been or will be negotiated.
  - (c) On the morning of the 19th, the Costa Rican Government will be advised that the treaty with Nicaragua will be announced that day. The purpose of this is to insure the Costa Ricans that the treaty is not being made as a move against Costa Rica.
  - 2. Since Mr. Leddy passed me the foregoing information in complicated double talk, you may wish to check back with him in the event that this does not fit in with such information that you may have.
