SUBJECT { GENERAL Operational
SPECIFIC EEI's

The following are EEI's on which information is desired at LINCOLN:

1. Labor Unions: location, strength, leaders, arms and equipment, how well are they trained, organization and morale, etc. This information can probably be obtained through FT/9.

2. Private and Official Residences of ARBENZ

- a. Private address and per cent of time used.
- b. Hideaway, pleasure, etc., per cent of time used.
- c. Pattern of use of above residences.
- d. If obtainable, attach a rough diagram of house, streets, grounds, exits, entrances, night illumination, exterior guard stations, interior guards, number of guards, number on duty each shift, time guard is changed, how are guards armed, overhead power lines, telephone lines, location of ARBENZ' bedroom, location of commo room, and guards' quarters.
- e. Describe security system in effect when ARBENZ travels, number of guards, type of vehicle, escort vehicles, pattern of travel, weapons, storage of vehicles.
- f. Prepare a study of ARBENZ' movements sufficient to indicate a pattern from which his location at a certain time can be predicted. Show time and places where most visible to the public. Sketch terrain, approach to vantage points overlooking such places, barriers, security points, escape and evasion routes.
- g. ARBENZ' commo system, power sources, regular and emergency, type of current, voltage, terrain approaches, showing barriers, security points, etc.
- h. Commo operator personnel, names, quarters, position.
- i. Telephone, telegraph, teletype: Entry of lines into various ARBENZ residences, height of lines, how supported, security points.

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j. Any other related data.

3. Major Standard Broadcast Stations:

- a. Regular and emergency power sources of TGW, TGWA, Radio Morse, TGR, TGNA, type of current, voltage, generator type, numbers, fuel storage, terrain approaches, station call or calls.
- b. Personnel list, technician staff, names, job, security measures.

Be extremely careful in assigning this EEI since the government is fully aware of our desire to obtain such information. A man used recently by CALLIGERIS to obtain such information was caught and imprisoned.

4. Main Railroad Terminal, Guatemala City

- a. Physical layout, use rough sketch, pinpoint traffic dispatch office, control center, commo center.
- b. Yard plans: general track and building layout, tracks leading out of terminal to exterior, yard control center, yard commo center, terrain approaches.
- c. Security measures: personnel, posts, weapons, routine.
- d. Power sources: main transformers, entry of commercial lines into terminal, emergency power, major facilities using emergency power, generators number and type used.
- e. Railroad facilities: major repair facilities, major traffic handling installations, turntables.
- f. Terminal security - personnel, weapons, posts, routine.

5. Since the ESODIGs are working on a list of army personnel, make sure they give branch of service, location, grade, etc., of the top personnel in all the military districts. Forward any and all OB on the Guatemalan Army which is available.
