- 1. HEGARTY is instructed to ask FAGE and GEUAGE to take the initiative in soliciting support from the organizations listed below. These organizations have been selected on the basis of their extensive contacts and their ability to propagandize effectively. In addition it is believed that they will respond favorably to PBSUCCESS groups. Some of the organizations are KUGOWN controlled and others have responded favorably to past KUGOWN actions. It is believed that the use of this list will not endanger KUGOWN if the initiative is taken by PBSUCCESS.
- 2. In approaching these groups personally or in writing maximum sympathy for PBSUCCESS objectives will be obtained if emphasis is placed on the totalitarian aspects of the present WSBURNT regime, linking the Communists with all other types of totalitarians. The democratic aspects of PBSUCCESS should at all times be emphasized.
