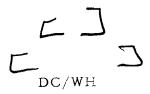

SUBJECT: Springiford Case
1. The above subject was discussed at a meeting with the Department of State held in Assistant Secretary Holland's office on 29 May 1956. Present at the meeting were: Mr. Holland, Mr. R. R. Rubottom, Mr. L. Randolph Higgs, Mr. Spencer M. King, and C.
discussed with Mr. Holland the contents of the attached memorandum based or meeting with the lawyer in touch with the law tirm handling the Springfjord case on behalf of the Guatemalan Government. Mr. Holland confirmed opinion that the thesis set forth in paragraph 1 is somewhat complex and not entirely convincing.
3. Inoted the most important feature of the report, which is that the United States underwriters are not actively pushing their claim against the Guatemalan Government and have not asked the Department of State for assistance. In also noted that it was the opinion of the General Counsel's office, CIA, that it would be inappropriate for the Department, in the absence of a request for assistance by the American underwriters, to take the action suggested by the British.
4. In oted that, while the foregoing is consistent with Ambassador Sparks' view, the Ambassador does feel that the matter should be brought to a conclusion, and recommended that, for the time being, the case rest in CIA's hands in order to determine whether there is a practical way of concluding the matter and also to decide whether Castillo should be consulted at this point.
5. Mr. King and

concluded that, through CIA channels, the Ambassador should be advised to send a message to the Department in regard to the permissive clause and stating in effect that he did not feel the time appropriate and wishes to withhold decision pending further consideration.
