1. AS PER PARA 4 OF REF NO ACTION HAS BEEN TAKEN AS YET BY

2. HOWEVER FOREIGN MINISTER WHEN INFORMED BY U.S. CHARGE THAT U.S. TO ESTABLISH RELATIONS WITH GUAT ON 13 JULY SAID ECUADOR WILL AWAIT DEVELOPMENTS RE ESTABLISHMENT "CONSTITUTIONAL" GOVT BEFORE DOING SO. MINISTER ADDED ECUADOR CONCERNED QUESTION 40 ASYLEES THEIR EMBASSY AND INTIMATED SOLUTION THIS QUESTION AND EARLY ISSUANCE SAFE CONDUCTS MIGHT REDUCE TIME FOR ECUADORAN RECOGNITION.

3. THIS [] OF OPINION THAT ECUADOR AS STAUNCH SUPPORTER OF RIGHT OF ASYLUM WILL CONTINUE SUPPORT THAT PRINCIPLE. MINISTER TOLD CHARGE THAT ECUADOR WOULD NOT ACCEPT CRIMINALS NOW IN THEIR EMBASSY FOR ENTRY INTO ECUADOR BUT WOULD NEVERTHELESS DEMAND SAFE CONDUCTS. WHERE ASYLEES WOULD GO IS NOT CLEAR.
