1. ON 9 JULY SOURCE REPORTED THAT [ ] HAD HAD LONG TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH GUATEMALAN CONSUL GRAJEDA, [ ] IN WHICH, COMMENTING ON POLITICAL SITUATION GUATEMALA, [ ] STATED HE HAD GOOD REASONS TO BELIEVE THAT WHOLE AFFAIR HAD BEEN ARRANGED IN ADVANCE BETWEEN MONZON AND ARBENZ.

2. SOURCE STATES THAT ACCORDING TO [ ] IT IS ALMOST CERTAIN THAT ARMAS WILL NOT BECOME PRESIDENT OF GUATEMALA. ON CONTRARY [ ] IS CONVINCED THAT ARMAS, AFTER HAVING PUT ON GOOD APPEARANCE FOR AMERICANS, WILL TURN FROM THEM AND REVEAL, AT THE TIME OF FUTURE ELECTIONS, THE INDIVIDUAL ON WHOSE BEHALF HE HAS ACTUALLY BEEN WORKING. ACCORDING TO [ ] THIS PERSON MAY BE NONE OTHER THAN IDIGORAS, EX-GUATEMALAN MINISTER LONDON WHO IS CURRENTLY IN SAN SALVADOR. THIS LATTER INDIVIDUAL IS PREPARING HIMSELF FOR TRIUMPHAL ENTRANCE INTO GUATEMALA.
