- 1. Reference a provided a short account of the first meeting of the undersigned with JUVIA II. Since that time four other meetings have been held, and it may be noted that the questions of personal danger to him and his family and the honor of his word because of promises made to ERRATIC have not been raised. JUVIA II has indicated by word and action that he will continue to work with us.
- 2. Upon receipt of Reference c consideration was given to several different means to approach ERRATIC. It was decided after consideration of all the factors involved that the best approach was through JUVIA II and that he could be relied upon to effectively convey to ERRATIC the contents of that message. We believe that he did make a sincere attempt to have ERRATIC join CALLIGERIS and doubt that anyone else would have met with better success.
- 3. It should be appreciated by all concerned that JUVIA II, at the request of ______ spent an enormous amount of time and effort in working with ERRATIC. It is obvious that he was and is highly impressed by ERRATIC, as are many other persons in this country who have personal knowledge of the man, and that he accepts to a large degree EHRATIC's criticisms of CALLIGERIS. JUVIA II does not pretent to be truly objective. There is no indication up to the present that JUVIA II has engaged in this project with a view toward possible later personal gain; his motivation is believed to be entirely patriotic.
- 4. There were certain very obvious mistakes made in the handling of EHRATIC, most of which stem from "promises" made to him due to misunder-standings and without proper authority. This situation, however, was not

the fault of JUVIA II, but was due to instructions relayed to JUVIA II by

5. JUVIA II stated that he will keep in contact with ERRATIC in order to keep us informed of ERRATIC's plans, insofar as possible. It is to be regretted that we do not have a true penetration of the ERRATIC Organization through facilities, and while consideration is being given to an attempt at possecration there are no immediate prospects known to us. Any ideas which you may have on this matter would be appreciated. Perhaps due to events as of 29 June such a consideration may be discarded.
