1. PRESS REACTION RECENT GUAT EVENTS NOT UNFAVORABLE BUT GENERAL ATTITUDE OF RESERVING JUDGEMENT UNTIL FULL FACTS KNOWN. PRINCIPLE DIFFICULTY IN FUTURE LINE BELIEVE TO BE EMPHASIS SO FAR IN U.P. AND A.P. DISPATCHES OF "INVASION" ASPECT WHICH UNDOUBTEDLY WILL PROVOKE FEELING SYMPATHY AMONG EVEN FRIENDLIEST ELEMENTS HERE.

2. STUDENT STRIKE IN PROGRESS 21 TO CONTINUE 22 JUNE. NUMEROUS ANTI U.S. POSTERS IN STREETS. DEMONSTRATION BY APPROXIMATELY 100 STUDENTS AT U.S. EMBASSY AFTERNOON 20 JUNE NO DAMAGE. DEMONSTRATION AT USIE LIBRARY 18 JUNE RESULTED ONE BROKEN SHOWCASE. 11 STUDENTS AND WORKERS ARRESTED, REPORTED TO BE COMMITTEES OR THIRD POSITIONISTS.

3. FURTHER DEMONSTRATIONS SCHEDULED EVENING 21 JUNE. COUNTERACTION CONTEMPLATED BY [] REQUEST URGENTLY BIOGRAPHICAL DATA CASTILLO ARMAS AND ANY BACKGROUND INFO TENDING EMPHASIZE THIS INTERNAL REVOLT RATHER THAN INVASION.
